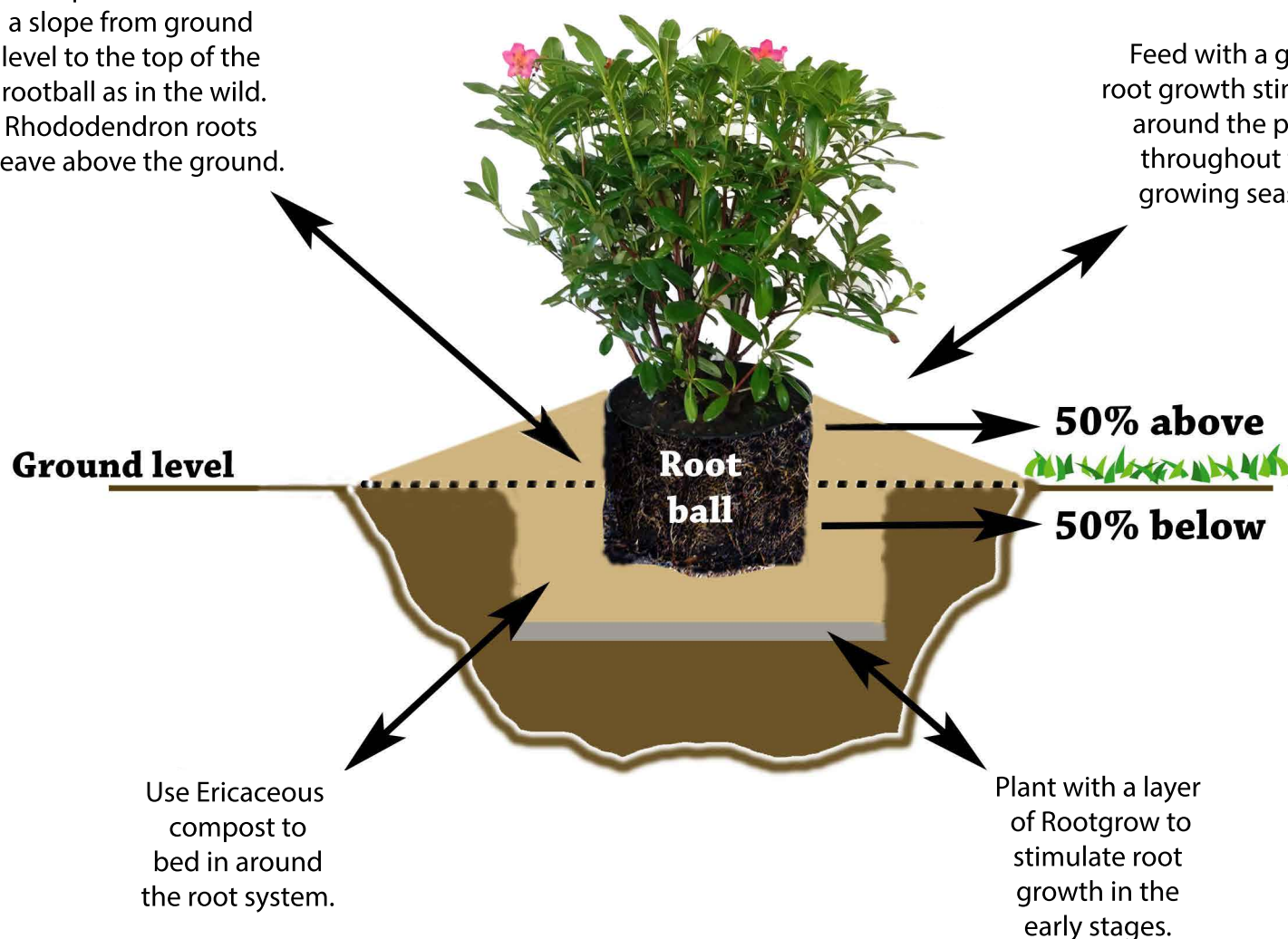


Guide on how to plant your Rhododendrons

Plant your Rhododendrons with 50% of the root ball below ground level and 50% above. This is essential to enable your plant to flourish. Improved aeration and drainage when using this planting method leads to a much healthier root system.

Use Ericaceous compost to create a slope from ground level to the top of the rootball as in the wild. Rhododendron roots heave above the ground.

Feed with a good root growth stimulant around the plant throughout the growing season.
